The purpose of the Information Technology class is to provide the student with a basic foundation and repairing microcomputer systems. The student will learn about assembling and identifying basic computer parts and developing troubleshooting techniques. The student will

learn about setting up and maintain equipment used to set up networking systems.

Students who complete this program will have passed the Microcomputer Repair Technician and the Microcomputer Networking Technician certifications issued by the

Oklahoma State Department of Career and Technical Education. This course also helps prepare the student to take the Comptia's A+ and Cisco's Certified System Engineering (CCNA) certification tests.

Students in this program will also have the opportunity to receive college credit through OSU-Okmulgee, Northern Oklahoma College, and Cowley County Community College.

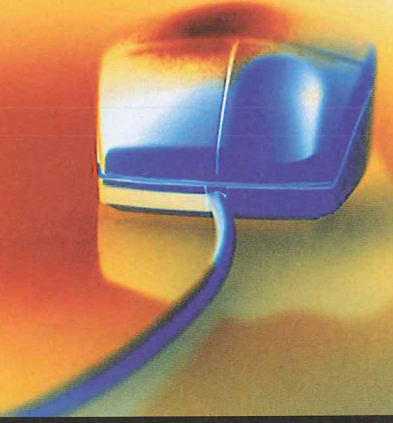
