Health Science Technology integrates classroom and clinical based activities that provide a foundation for a variety of health related occupations. In order to better meet the scheduling constraints of today's student, it is now possible to tailor your health care education to include a core curriculum of: Safety and Asepsis, Legal and Ethical Issues, Medical Math, Assessment Techniques, Mobility, Professional Development, Health Care Systems, CPR & First Aid, Communications, Anatomy and Physiology, and Introduction to and Advanced Medical Terminology. Upon completion of the core curriculum, students may choose to study a variety of specialty pathways including Nursing Assistant, OT/PT Aide, Dental Assistant, Pharmacy Technician, Veterinary Assistant, Phlebotomy Technician and Medical Assistant. On-site clinical training is a vital component provided with these choices. School certification is awarded for each completed pathway and National and State certification exams are available for some pathways. College credit is available to concurrently enrolled students and high school students may use this course as a science credit toward graduation requirements.

Health Science Technology offers both traditionally structured, instructor-directed lecture and discussion-based learning as well as student centered, self-paced curriculum. This flexibility meets your needs whether you are a student who needs a definitive organized learning environment or a student who is highly motivated, desiring the freedom to study at his or her own pace. This flexibility allows you to complete individualized programs of study in a time frame ranging from one to four semesters. Job placement for these entry-level certifications is very good and educational preparation for degree programs is excellent.
