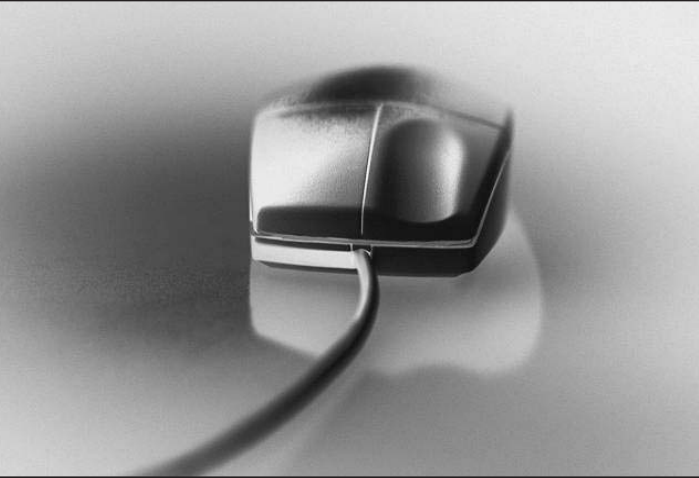

Information Technology

The primary purpose of the Information Technology class is to provide you with a basic foundation of building and repairing microcomputer systems. You will learn about assembling and identifying basic computer parts and developing troubleshooting techniques.

The ultimate entry-level computer repair certification is Comptia's Computer A+. The objectives of the Information Technology class are focused around this certification. Earning this certificate allows you to set yourself apart as a technician with exceptional computer troubleshooting skills. Most of the students who complete the first year of the Information Technology have passed two certifications by the Oklahoma State Department of Career and Technical Education. The two certifications are Microcomputer Repair Technician and Microcomputer Networking Technician.

The majority of those who complete this program continue their training in the Computer Repair/Network program. That program is designed to train you in the upper levels of network management.
